### **Metro Area Bicycle Planning Workshop for North Liberty rescheduled to February 19**

**February 6, 2019 (NORTH LIBERTY)**– The Metro Area Bicycle Planning Workshop that was cancelled due to weather has now been rescheduled. **The North Liberty workshop will take place on Tuesday, February 19, from 6:00-7:30 PM at the North Liberty Community Center.**

Another workshop will be held at the Coralville Public Library on Tuesday, February 12, from 6:00 to 7:30 PM as originally planned.

Residents of Coralville, North Liberty, Tiffin, and University Heights as well those interested in general bicycling conditions in Johnson County are welcome to attend either event. Public input gathered through these events will help set a foundation for the plan in terms of future facilities, road and trail improvements, and policies and programs that make bicycling safer and easier.

These initial public workshops will include a brief overview of the planning process and existing conditions. Attendees will provide input on existing barriers identified through a recent online survey as well as opportunities for better connectivity between metro communities and to the county trail system. While the plan does not cover Iowa City, it will consider connections to planned facilities identified in the Iowa City Bicycle Master Plan, adopted in 2017.

The Metro Bicycle Master Plan will guide future investments in bicycle facilities as well as changes in policies and programs that impact bicycling in these communities.
