

RESOLUTION NO. 18-37

**RESOLUTION CONCERNING PARKING, TRAFFIC, AND  
OTHER REGULATIONS DURING RAGBRAI**

**WHEREAS**, the Des Moines Register's Annual Great Bicycle Ride Across Iowa (RAGBRAI) will pass near University Heights on July 27-28, 2018, including an overnight stop in Iowa City; and

**WHEREAS**, the University Heights City Council desires to welcome RAGBRAI riders and their support teams and to encourage citizens to host RAGBRAI participants and to support and celebrate the event in other ways, including having participants camp out on yards; and

**WHEREAS**, the University Heights City Council desires to establish certain regulations for RAGBRAI's time in the community pursuant to the Council's authority and jurisdiction to adopt regulations for the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the community,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of University Heights, Iowa that the following regulations shall be in effect during RAGBRAI's visit to the community July 27-28, 2018:

1. Parking of motor vehicles will be permitted on yards with the permission of the property owner and/or property residents.
2. Parking on streets shall be at the discretion and direction of the University Heights Chief of Police.
3. Traffic regulation shall be at the discretion and direction of the University Heights Chief of Police to protect the health and safety of residents, motorists, bicyclists, and support teams.
4. While music and noise that audibly crosses property lines is prohibited, citations for noise shall be at the discretion of the University Heights Chief of Police consistent with the city's intention to encourage citizens to host bikers.
5. Sales of goods, merchandise, or services from property within a residential zone shall remain restricted as provided in Ordinance No. 81, which permits only sales from home occupations (defined to allow those living at the property to sell items that they prepare on the premises).

6. Signs, banners, and flags are permitted to be displayed with the permission of the property owner and/or property residents.
7. Portable toilets may be placed on residential properties without visibility or other restrictions from July 25-29, 2018, with the permission of the property owner and/or property residents.
8. The above regulations, other than the portable toilet regulations, shall be in effect from 8:00 a.m. July 27, 2018, until 5:00 p.m. July 28, 2018.
