Mayor Pro Tem From called to order a public hearing of the Council at 7:04 p.m.

Present: Council Members From, Gay, Jones, Martin, Schoenmaker; Attorney Ballard; Treasurer Reitz; Clerk Birk.

Absent: Mayor Jacobson.

Council met to amend the budget for the current fiscal year. Increases in expenses and decreases in income this year equal \$54,000 more than was budgeted. No members of the public were in attendance, and no public comment was received.

Treasurer Reitz revisited the income and expense information that she distributed at the May meeting. General fund income will be \$12,800 less than anticipated. There are increases in expenses for the police budget (\$9,000, including \$5,000 for defibrillators), curb numbering (\$2,678), tree removal (\$3,763), building inspection fees (\$1,000), legal fees (\$17,500), accounting fees (\$1,345), street improvements (\$3,500), and snow removal (\$1,345).
