

ORDINANCE NO. 109 (as amended)

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING KEEPING A DISORDERLY HOUSE.

Section 1. DISORDERLY HOUSE PROHIBITED. No person shall permit or continue to allow any quarreling, fighting or loud, disagreeable noises to the disturbance of the neighborhood or general public upon any premises, within the corporate limits of city of University Heights, Iowa, owned by the person or in the person's possession, without taking legal steps to prevent the same. For the purposes of this section, "General Public" includes persons beyond the subject premises and/or persons upon public places, including law enforcement officers.

Section 2. PENALTY. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance commits a simple misdemeanor punishable by confinement for up to 30 days in jail or by a \$500.00 fine or by both such confinement and fine.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
